DURING COVID-19

Before you Travel:

- If you have an elevated temperature, any symptoms of COVID-19, or any known exposure in the last 14 days, please contact us to reschedule your visit.

When You Arrive:

- You must report to the Business Office in the Paulo Administration Building upon your arrival. There you will be given a temperature check and a brief health screening. You will receive a visitor sticker.
- This must be repeated each day of your stay before interacting with any students, faculty, or staff. Please wear the sticker you are given in a visible area at all times.

During Your Stay:

- Continue to monitor yourself for any symptoms, or elevated temperature
- Practice good health hygiene.
- Please wear your visitor's sticker in a visible area at all times.
- Masks are available in the Paulo Building Administration office

COVID-19 Understanding:

This event and activities are publicly attended and could expose you to COVID-19. According to governmental health organizations, COVID-19 poses a risk to all people of mild to severe illness.
